### PRESENTATION

After Seoul (2013 and 2014), Montreal (2016), Bilbao (2018) and Mexico City (2021), the **city of Dakar** will host the 6<sup>th</sup> edition of the Global Social and Solidarity Economy Forum (GSEF Dakar 2023), from **1 to 6 May 2023**. It will be co-organised with the **Network of Stakeholders and Local Authorities for** SSE, in partnership with the **Senegal Ministry of Microfinance and SSE**.

The Global Social and Solidarity Economy (SSE) Forum is a major international SSE meeting, held every other year and bringing together all SSE stakeholders to share practices, policies and visions to build a more inclusive, equitable, mutually supportive and human-centred world.

**GSEF DAKAR 2023's** main theme is:*the transition from the 'informal' economy to collective, sustainable economies for territories.* It will bring together between 3,500 and 4,500 people from nearly 100 countries and be structured around seven themes and three special events devoted to young people and women.

The 2023 edition of GSEF in Dakar provides the opportunity to promote an economy adapted to our realities and which encourages job creation aimed at young people and women through the social and solidarity approach.

It will showcase programmes and initiatives relating to our economies' various activity sectors and to a set of innovative ways of providing accompaniment in the service of social inclusion and sustainable growth to support the most vulnerable members of society.

The Forum thus wishes to be a mechanism for the development of an inclusive, fair economy and a catalyst for change. It will provide an opportunity to advocate an African position with respect to the social and solidarity economy and to present an alternative development model, boosting job creation and encouraging the numerous initiatives promoted by young people and women, emphasising training and innovation.

Our ambition for this 6<sup>th</sup> edition is to open new development prospects and new opportunities with the different stakeholders from the SSE ecosystem from throughout the world and more particularly from African countries to prove that another world is possible, a world that is more inclusive, more equitable and more unified for our collective well-being.

We thus invite you to join us from 1 to 6 May 2023 in Dakar, Senegal for a meeting of "giving and receiving" that will fly the SSE flag.

## **CONFERENCES AND WORKSHOPS**

Around 50 individual sessions, plenary sessions, a ministers' panel, a mayors' panel, an experts' panel, special events (Youth and SSE Pre-forum, Women's Day for SSE, the SSE Integration Caravan), side-events organised by exhibitors and partners in order to share and capitalise upon experiences and to jointly shape a future for the SSE.
